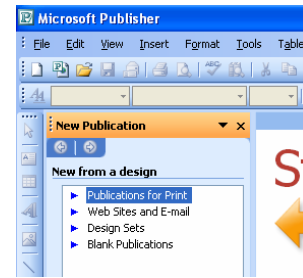
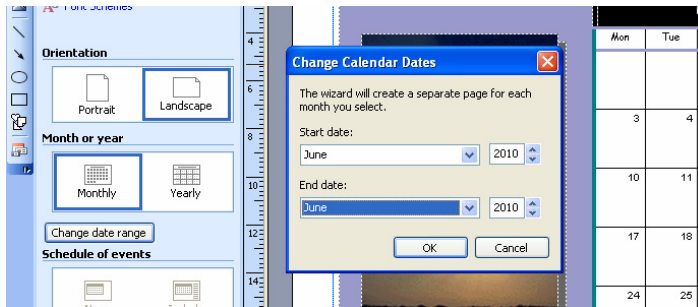


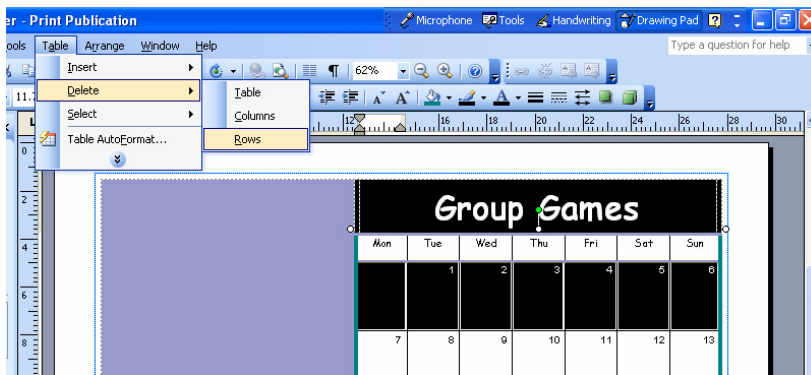
Making a World Cup planner

1. Start Publisher and select 'Publications for Print' and then 'Calendar'...



2. Once you have chosen a calendar style press on the 'change date range' button and select only June 2010.

3. We do not need the first row of the calendar. Highlight it and select 'Delete → Rows'...



4. Then delete the bottom row of the table (the 28th June onwards).

5. Make your calendar look good by adding appropriate images. Change the title to show the country you are making a world cup planner for.



6. Finally, use your internet research skills to find the dates of the group games for your chosen country. You will need to think carefully about the search terms you use.
