



Step One: Teacher Account Creation

To make your teacher account, go to www.what2learn.com and click the 'Sign Up' link. You will then need to complete the registration form. Make sure that you select 'Teacher' from the user type option. Do not worry about what age group you teach (e.g. KS3 or KS4) you select as you can change this from within your account. This process will require you to click on a link that is emailed to you to activate your account.



Step Two: Student Account Creation

Students must create their own accounts. We have found that the easiest way for this to happen is for you to make an email account on a service like yahoo. Write this email address on your board and get students to enter it when creating accounts. If you have this email address open you can click to activate the accounts as they appear. If your class are all able to quickly and easily access their own email address they could use it as an alternative, but we have found that this slows the process down.



Step Three: Link to your students

As soon as students log in to What2Learn they must enter your teacher reference number into the 'Share Code' box on their dashboard. This will enable you to see their scores and help them with usernames and passwords should they forget them. Your unique teacher reference number is displayed on your dashboard...

Step Four: Play Learning Games!

To access the interactive learning activities students should click on 'Play' on the menu. They will then need to select a subject from the drop-down and press 'Show' to see the available activities for that subject.
